2021 SUMMER ATHLETIC PROGRAM COVID SAFETY PARTICIPANT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The University of North Texas places program participant safety first. By participating in a summer program on the UNT campus, you agree to campus safety and COVID health guidelines. UNT will be taking these additional precautions to ensure the health and wellness of our summer program participants.

General Safety Rules

Program participants agree to follow all required COVID safety protocols for the duration of the program. Program participants who repeatedly violate safety protocols will be sent home.

General Health Guidelines

Program participants are asked to monitor their health for 14 days before starting the summer program. This is an important step in preventing the spread of COVID-19. Symptoms include: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea. Participants may not attend the program if they have tested positive for COVID-19, exhibited COVID-19 symptoms or have come in contact with someone who has tested positive in the 14 days before the program begins or at any time during the program.

If a participant becomes ill or exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, they will be sent home immediately. For minors, a parent or guardian should be available to pick up a participant at any time during the entirety of the program. Ill participants may be contacted for contact tracing purposes and advised if they can return to the program.

COVID-19 Testing Requirement

COVID-19 testing is required for all athletic program participants. All participants must have a negative COVID-19 test on the first day of camp. For multi-day programs, testing will take place every two days.

Participants may be exempt from the testing requirement if they voluntarily provide proof of being fully vaccinated. You are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after the end dose of Pfizer or Moderna and 14 days after a single dose of Johnson & Johnson.

Contact Tracing

Participants and the parent/guardian of a minor are expected to notify program staff if they test positive for COVID-19 during the program. Contact tracing efforts will be conducted if it is necessary to identify program participants who may have been in contact with a participant who has tested positive for COVID-19. Participants are expected to answer questions about contact with other participants and follow directions regarding further participation in the program. Information gathered during this process will be kept confidential to the extent

possible and only used for the purpose of identifying those who may have been exposed to COVID-19.

By signing below, I acknowledge the aforementioned COVID-19 safety requirements and authorize UNT to conduct contact tracing on me or the minor participant named below if positive for COVID-19 and further authorize UNT to share information as necessary for contact tracing purposes.
